

Return to Viet Nam

- Day 1 – Fly to HCMC (Saigon)
- Day 2 – Arrive HCMC
- Day 3 – Spend day/night in HCMC, rent a bus to Nha Trang; take train to Nha Trang?
- Day 4 – Travel to Nha Trang
- Day 5 – Nha Trang – Beach, Cham Towers, church, market, Institute of Oceanography, Boat tours, etc.

- Day 8 – Travel to individual team sites, Quy Nhon, Bong Son, Ban Me Thout, Pleiku, etc.

- Day 12 – Travel to Nha Trang
- Day 13 – Nha Trang
- Day 14 – Travel to Da Lat
- Day 15 – Da Lat

- Day 18 – HCMC
- Day 19 – HCMC
- Day 20 – Travel and arrive USA
- Day 21 – Rest

Obviously, this is for a 3 week trip. It can easily be reduced to 2 weeks by spending less time in Nha Trang, HCMC, and the individual team sites. Or if one has more time, this can be expanded.

Another alternative would be to plan a “whirlwind” tour through Viet Nam. I have opted not to do this. I have not visited the Mekong Delta or north of the former DMZ. I would rather miss a few sights, and relax in fewer places. The above itinerary should give everyone enough leeway to do what they want.
